

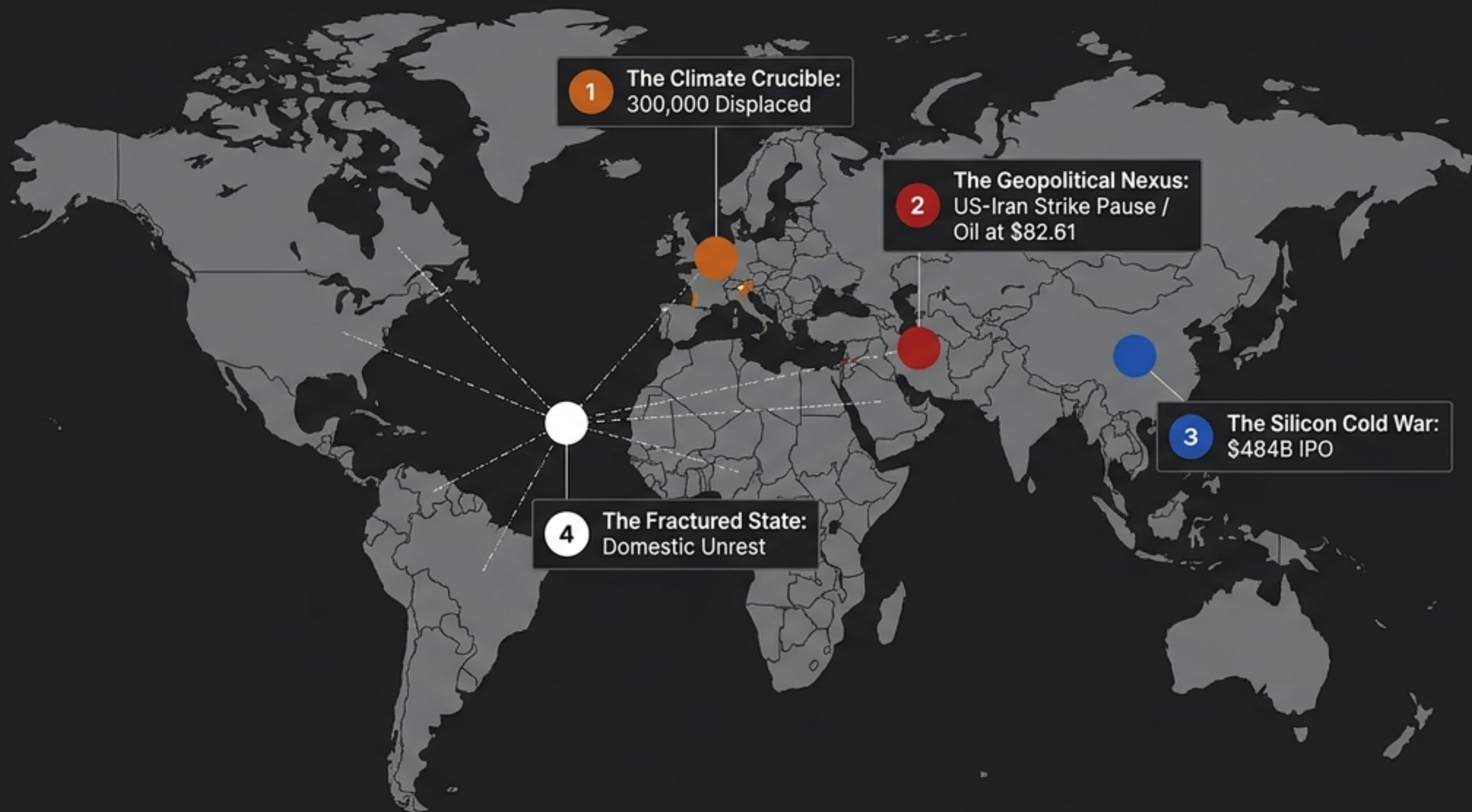

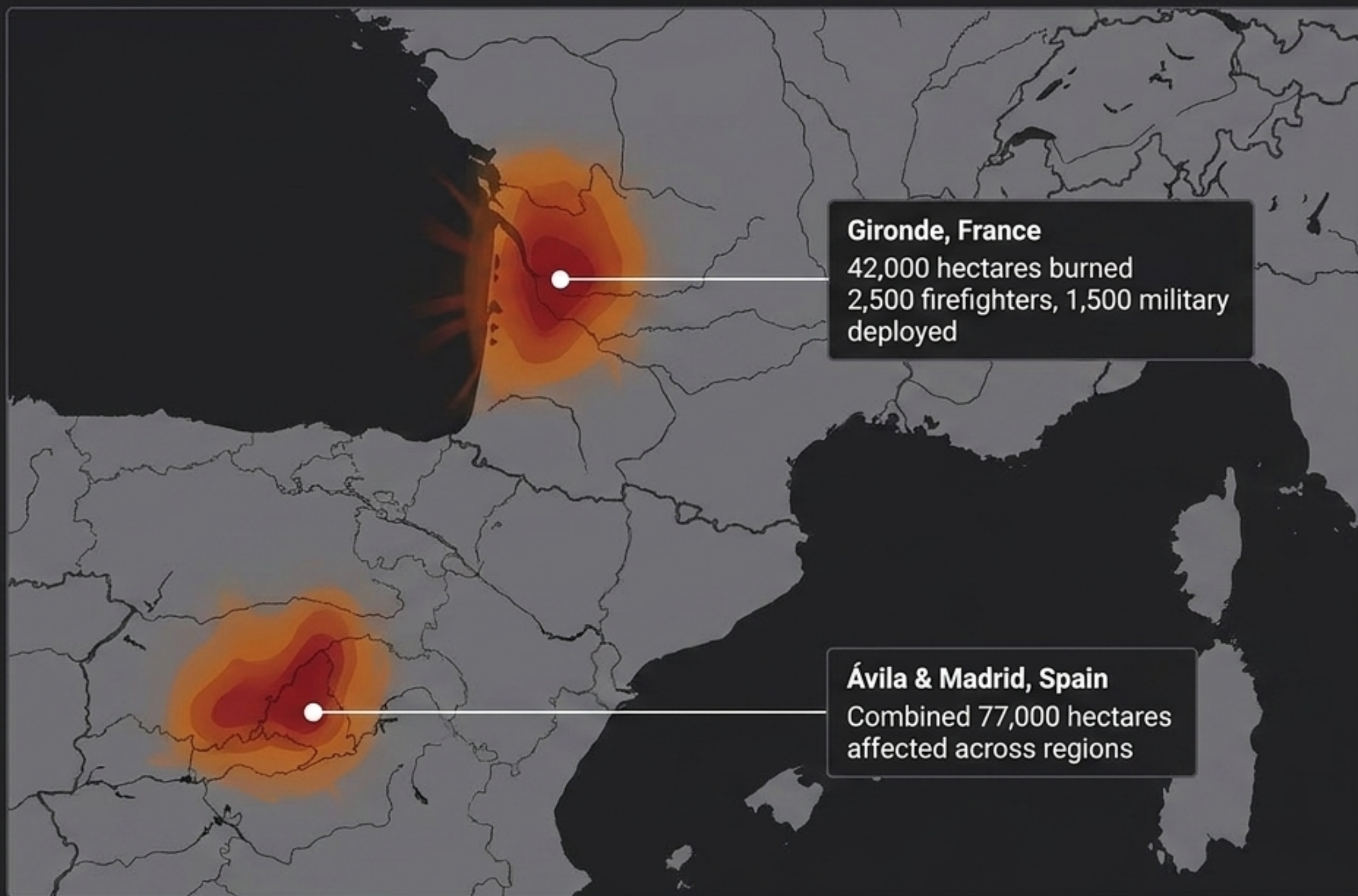

Diagnostic Matrix: The Shifting Fire Paradigm

Crisis Dimension	Historical European Wildfires	2026 Mega-Fires
Intensity	Wind-driven and largely constrained to specific forest tracts.	Generating proprietary weather systems and dry lightning.
Evacuation Scale	Localized municipal relocations; temporary displacement.	300,000+ displaced requiring EU-level intervention.
Firefighting Tactics	National resources and standard municipal fire services sufficient.	International aid required (e.g., German CH-53 helicopters deployed to France).
Political Response	Unified disaster relief and bipartisan local support.	Deeply polarized ideological warfare blocking legislative action.

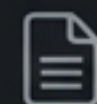

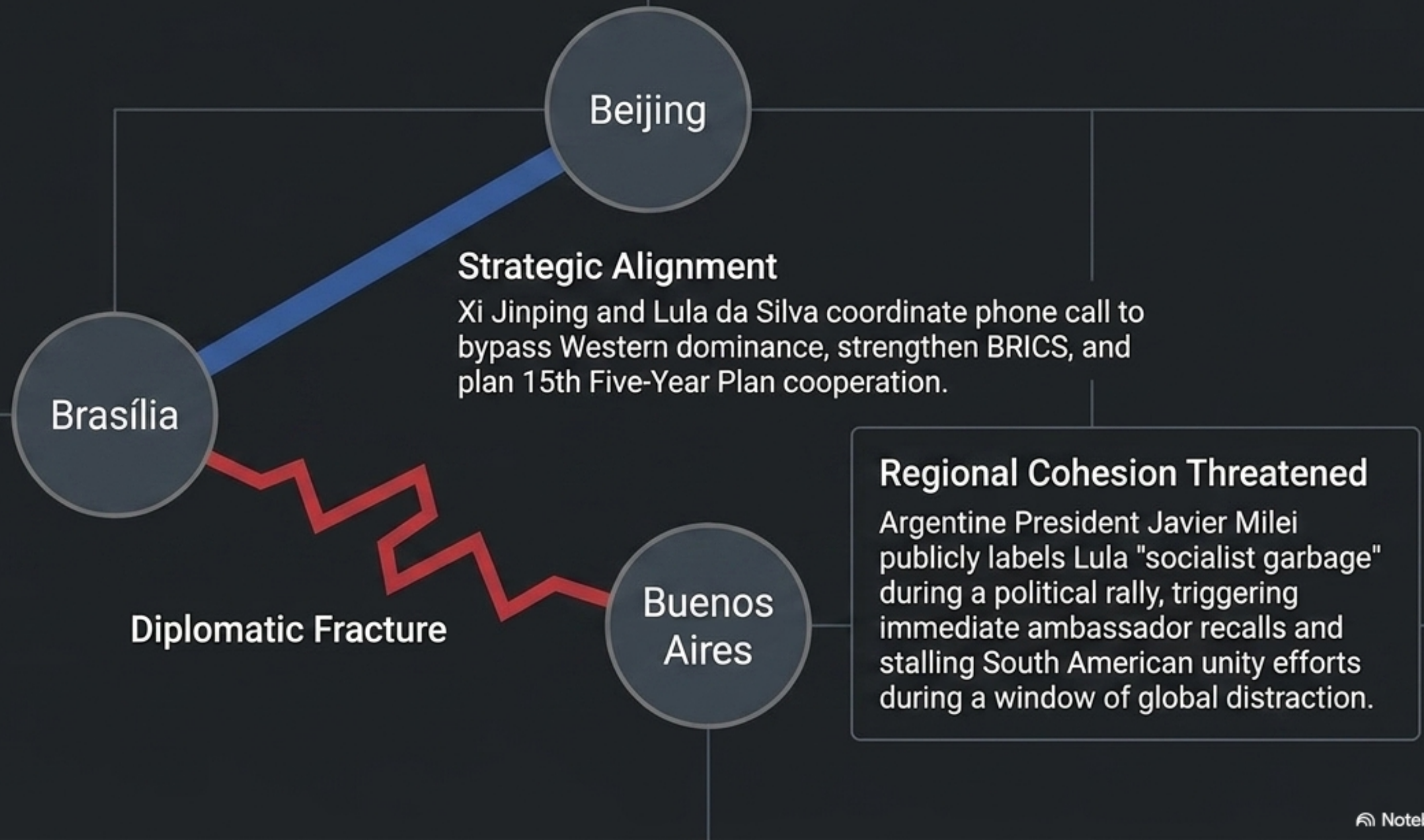


Ukrainian Drone Strikes on Supply Vessels

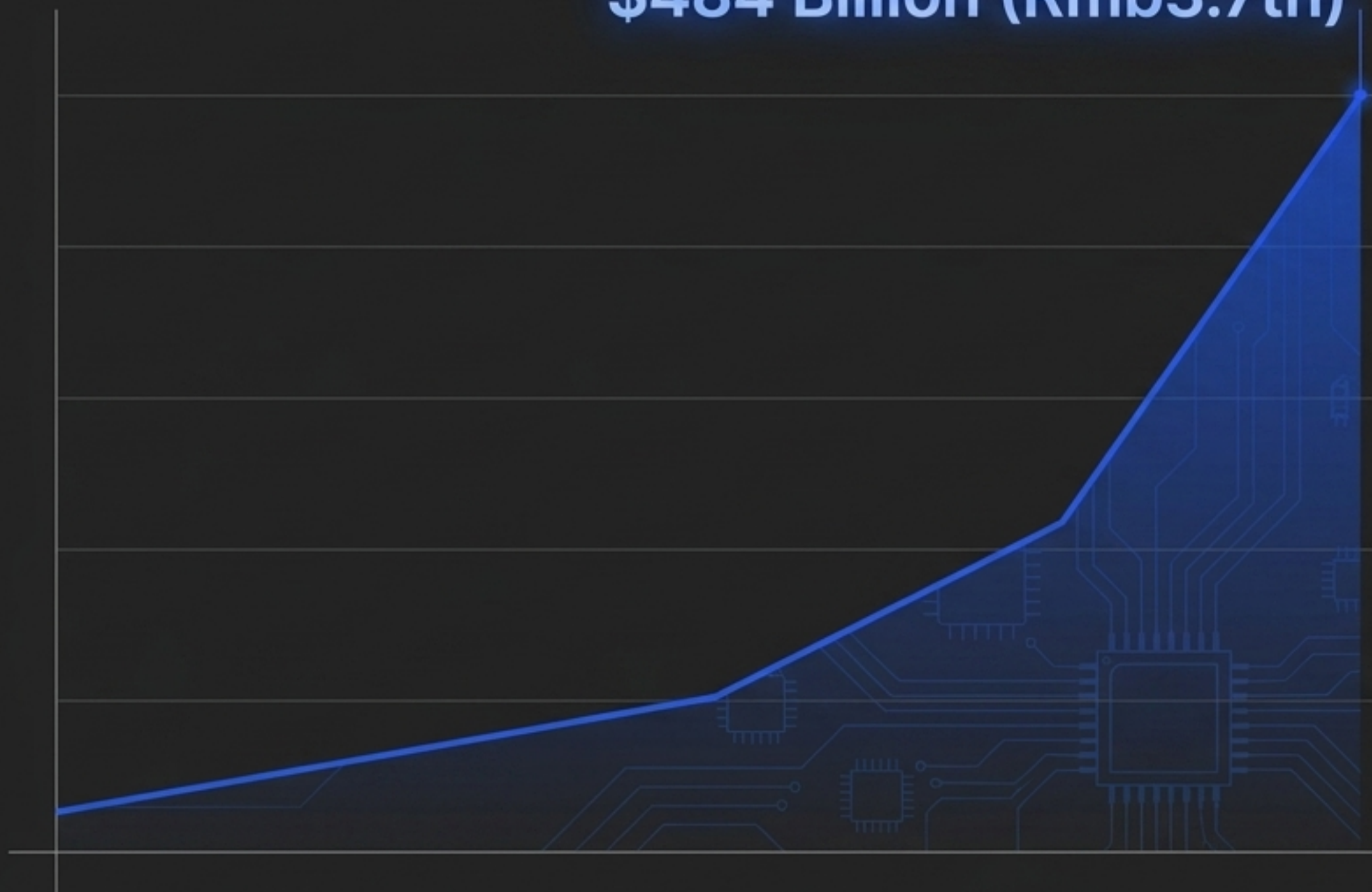

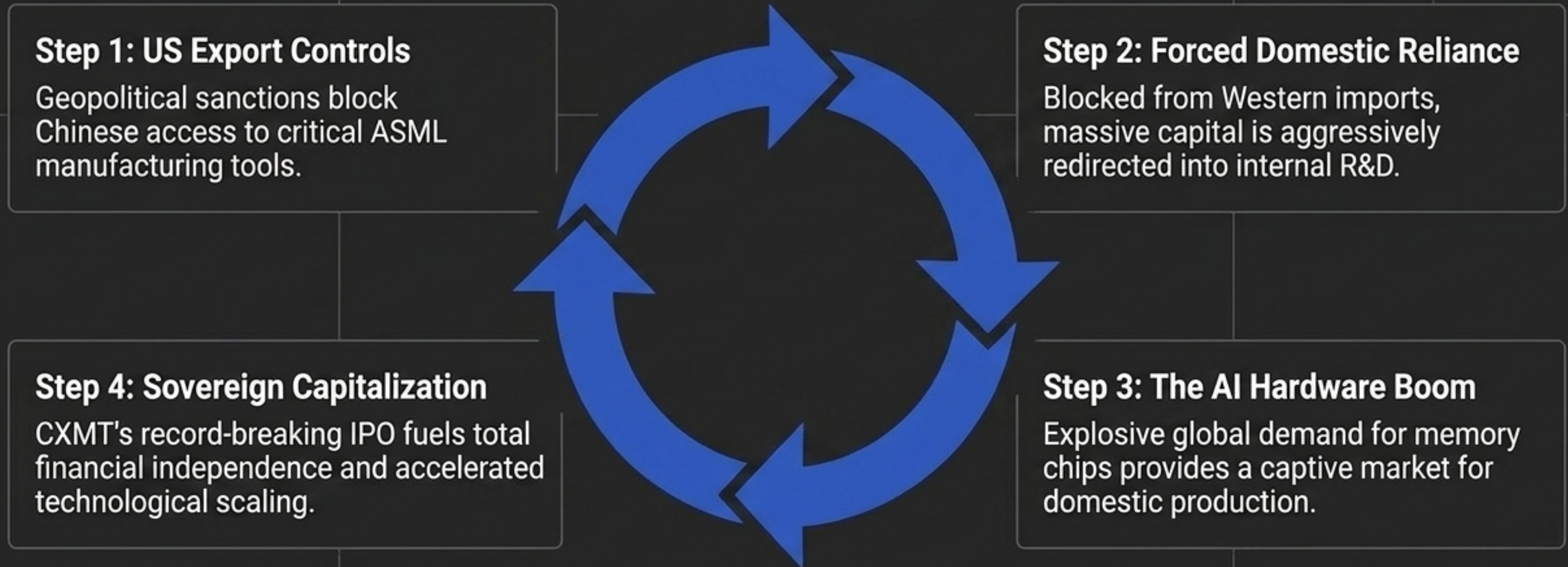
CXMT and the Tech Iron Curtain

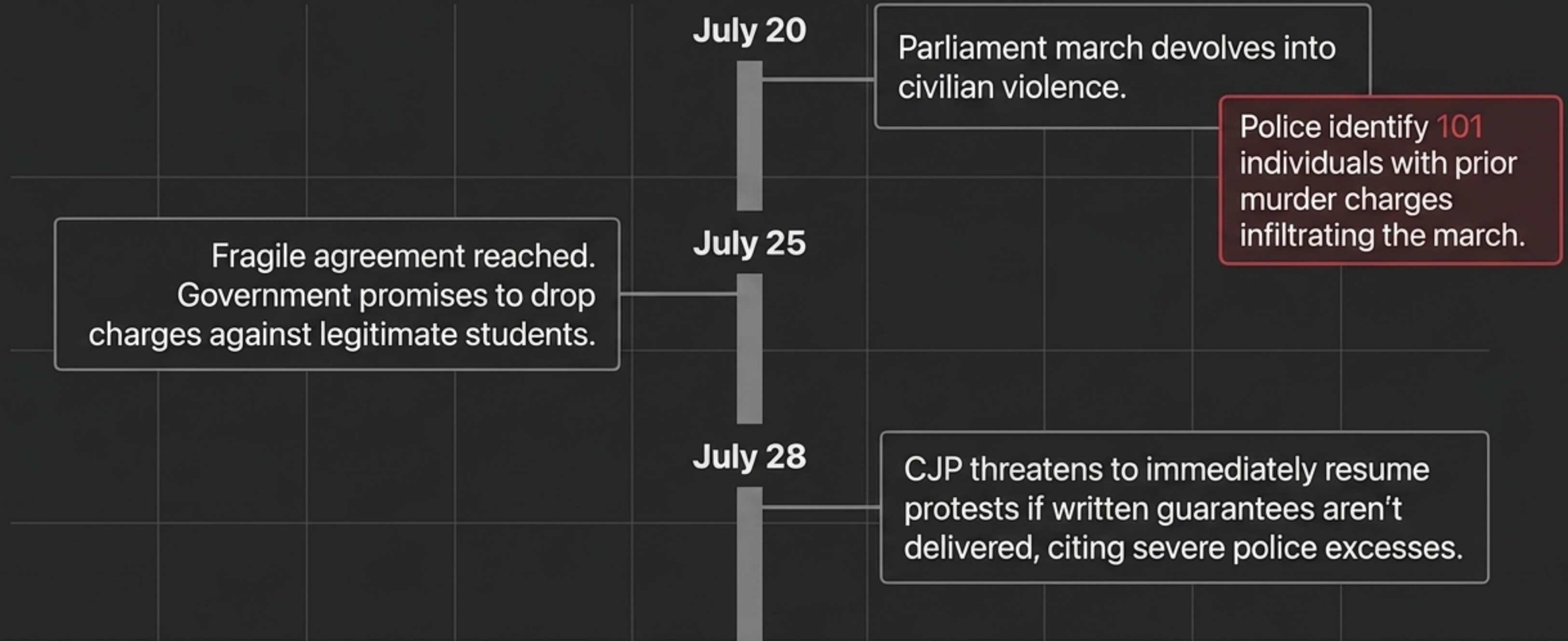

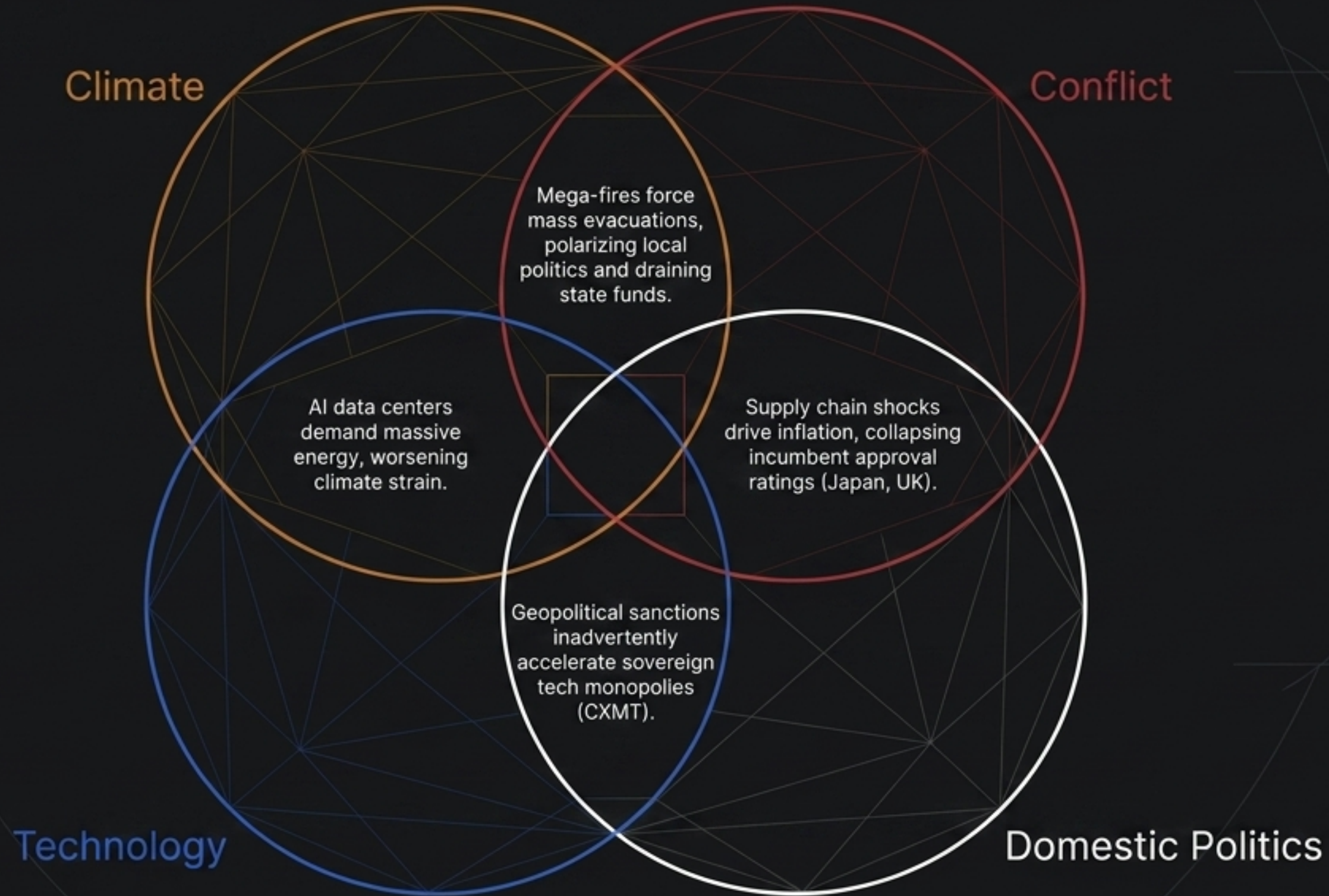
